

# Mole Removal

## Cosmetic Shave

A technique that removes the area of elevation but not the root.

**What to expect:** After a numbing injection, the mole will be shaved flat. The root is not removed (to avoid an indentation) and there is a chance of possible re-growth. Cautery will be used to seal the wound. The procedure takes ~15 minutes. Risks include scarring, infection and recurrence.

**Post-care:** We recommend Cicaplast or Vaseline to help with wound healing. Healing time is ~7 days.

**Cost:** \$175-\$250\*

## Cosmetic Deep Excision

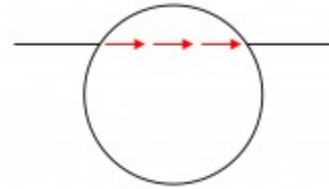
The entire lesion will be removed including the root. A linear scar will result due to surgical closure.

**What to expect:** After a numbing injection, the spot will be removed to the level of fat. Sutures will be used to close the incision. This will take ~30 mins. Risks are as above.

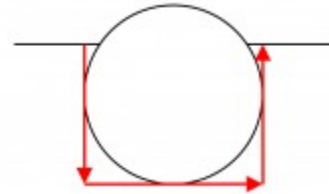
**Post-care:** as above. Healing time is ~10-14 days and suture removal is usually at 7-14 days.

**Cost:** \$275-\$350\*
