

Platelet-Rich Plasma Injections

For Hair Loss & Skin Rejuvenation

Platelet- Rich Plasma (PRP) contains growth factors that can stimulate the function of cells.

How does it work? For hair loss, PRP to slow growing or resting hair roots can move them into active growth to increase hair density and caliber.

For aging skin and scarring, PRP encourages skin cells to produce more structure and support (collagen and elastic tissue). It also encourages quicker healing after microneedling and peels.

How is it done? We first obtain blood from the arm of the patient and centrifuge it into red blood cells, platelet-poor plasma and the platelet-rich plasma. The platelet-rich plasma is then drawn up and injected into the same person in the area of concern (i.e. scalp, face).

PRP therapy is usually administered every 4-6 weeks for the first three treatments, with maintenance treatments every 4-6 months after that.

Maintenance

- For hair loss: at-home treatments include: Rogaine, Neoptide Anti-Hair Loss Lotion and Anaphase shampoo.
- For skin rejuvenation: we recommend serums with vitamins C and A.
- For acne scarring: we recommend a vitamin A (retinoid) cream
